Voyage features a fleet of 300 illuminated boats which creates a magical landscape on Burj Lake. On display until December 2nd, Voyage is created by the multi-disciplinary art & design studio Aether & Hemera and forms part of the Art Emaar initiative, which aims to bring art to the wider community.



The fleet of boats composes an organic matrix of lights that uses the water as a canvas for drawing ever-changing coloured lighting effects to create an imaginative and immersive magical landscape. Enjoyed from the mall's Waterfront Promenade, guests can connect to the 'Voyage WIFI' and interact with this installation, changing patterns and colours to create an ever-changing landscape.



In addition, guests goy a sneak peek of the Jaan-e-Jigar, the spectacular Broadway-style Bollywood musical from Bollywood Parks Dubai with live shows on the Waterfront Promenade near Voyage.

The Dubai Fountains also has two exclusive shows for Diwali, choreographed to the Bollywood classic 'Dhoom Taana' from November 7th-11th at 2:00pm and 8:00pm daily.
